MUSÉE D'ART DE PULLY

Art and artistic techniques

1 VISIT: THE WORLD OF ART AND THE MUSÉE EXHIBITIONS

Suggested age group: 4 to 15 years old

A guided tour designed to shed light on different artistic movements and intellectual contexts through the work of the artist displayed at the Musée d'art at the moment of the visit. A trained guide will encourage pupils' participation stimulating them with questions, discussion, readings and practical experiences for the whole length of the visit.

2 WORKSHOP: ARTISTIC TECHNIQUES AND ARTISTIC PRACTICES

Suggested age group: 6 to 12 years old

This workshop allows pupils to experiment different artistic techniques. Inspired by the work of the artist displayed at the Musée d'art at the time of their visit, pupils will try their hands at engraving, drawing or working with acrylic painting. They will create their own piece to take back home.

VILLA ROMAINE AND ARCHÉOLAB

Archaeology, ancient history and ancient science

VISIT: THE VILLA ROMAINE AND LIFE IN ANTIQUITY

Suggested age group: 6 to 15 years old

This visit combines the presentation of the Villa's current exhibition with an interactive discussion and several practical experiences. The aim of the visit is to discover and reflect on a wide range of aspect of ancient Romans' life and culture: food, writing, building, cosmetics, ect.

WORKSHOP: THE ARCHÉOLAB AND WHAT IS LIKE TO BE AN ARCHAEOLOGIST

Suggested age group: 7 to 12 years old

This workshop allows pupils to try their hands with the work of an archaeologist. With the help of a microscope, magnifying glasses and interactive screens, they will learn how to restore a ceramic pot, to identify the skeleton of a cat or a chicken, how to cast a coin or to observe the shape of ancient pollens.

WALKING TOUR

Suggested age group : 6 to 15 years old

A fascinating walking tour through the historic town of Pully to discover its cultural and social history from the Neolithic to present days. The tour includes a visit of the Villa Romaine and the Musée d'art. A fun, interactive walk that aims at sharpening the pupils' understanding of global history through discussion and reflection on the lives of local historic figures.

PRACTICAL INFORMATION

All workshops and visits last about 1 hour and 30 minutes with the exception of the walking tour which lasts approximately 2 hours. Teachers must be present during the whole length of the activities and they are responsible for their group.

We regularly provide dedicated visits for teachers in order to provide them with the necessary learning resources to prepare pupils for their visit or workshop.
